

Key Questions

What is ice made from? What happens to ice when it gets warm? What is the Arctic/Antarctic like? What is the weather like in winter? How can we keep warm in winter? Where do penguins live? What adaptations do penguins have to live in cold places?

EAD / Art Processes and Techniques

Use different techniques and materials to make textures on Gruffalo and other characters

Make winter scene picture: colour mixing, splatter paint, sponge, cotton wool
