GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS

From May 25th, 2018, the way we manage data and information in the school is changing and we have appointed Global Policing to act as the school's data protection officers. General Data Protection Regulations give parents, children, teachers and anyone we hold information on the power to request:

1. To arrange an appointment to view all the information we hold on you.
2. To ask for the information to be changed.
3. To ask for the information to be deleted.
