



### What we have been up to this week in KS2

**Year 3:** This week the children have been learning about right angle turns in Maths and writing non-chronological reports in Literacy. In theme lessons the children are looking at capital cities of the world, specifically, Brasilia, Washington and London.

**Year 4:** This week we have been learning about time in Maths. We looked at the difference between analogue and digital times. We also looked at how to calculate times earlier or later. In Literacy we have been looking at apostrophes and composing a balanced argument about whether school uniform should be banned,

**Year 5:** This week we have been learning about measure in Maths. We took part in an active measure challenge and also learned how to convert between units of measure. In Literacy we have been applying our spelling and grammar skills and have started drafting our first draft of our Treasure Island chapter. We have invented some of our own interesting characters!

**Year 6:** In Maths this week Year 6 have been calculating the volume of 3D shapes and learning to recognise a range of 3D nets. In Literacy we have been writing letters and diaries based on being satranded on a desert island.
