What we have been up to this week in LKS2

Year 3: We have been counting in multiples of 4s, 8s, 50s and 100s, looking at the patterns we can see and using maths equipment, like 100 squares, to help us.

We have been exploring the book, *The Stone Age Boy*. We have been developing our language, using and punctuating speech, planning out the story and creating a new character.

We learnt and practised a song in French, we have been creating dances with partners in PE and exploring how magnets repel and attract each other.

Year 4: This week in maths we have been rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We have also been learning about decimals, what they mean and their fraction equivalents.

In literacy we have finished reading our first instalment of *Beowulf*. We have written a character description of *Beowulf* and have planned our own independent character descriptions of a unicorn.
