What we have been up to this week in LKS2

In LKS2 it has been assessment week and all the classes have been showing the fantastic progress they have made in the Autumn term. On Wednesday we attended a road safety workshop, which taught us how to cross roads safely and be aware of potential danger. Collectively as a school, we made up 107 boxes for our homeless appeal which will be presented next week. Well done everyone!

Year 3: In Maths, we have been applying our knowledge of multiplication and division methods to solve a range of number and word problems. We have also developed our understanding of formal written methods of short division. In Literacy, we have learned about word families and classes and have developed our understanding of various types of adverbs.

Year 4: In Maths, we have started to learn about time. We have looked at calendars and identified o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past, using analogue clocks. We have also been practising using our four operations through arithmetic. In Literacy, we have been learning about diaries. We have identified the features of a diary and compared various diary entries. We have also started reading 'A Christmas Carol' and have explored the story through drama.
