



What we have been up to this week in UKS2

Year 5: In Maths this week we have been learning how to calculate the area and perimeter of compound shapes.

In English we have started reading 'Treasure Island' and will be using it as the stimulus for our next piece of assessed writing.

Year 6: This week in year 6 we have continued to answer questions involving algebra. Children have been learning to write their own formulae and substitute values into algebraic equations.

In English we have been reading a range of information texts and identifying the features. Next week children will be creating their own information texts about coastlines and their features.
