Year 5: This week in Maths, we have been answering questions involving time. This has involved converting time and reading information in timetables.

In English we been writing our own chapter for our class read 'Treasure Island.'

Year 6: This week in Maths Year 6 have been converting between different units of measures. Children found the conversion between miles and kilometres particularly challenging.

In English we have been reading selected chapters of 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe' and focused on answer vocabulary questions that test the children's understanding of words in context.

Next week formal assessments will be carried out in all subjects and results reported to parents.
