What we have been up to in LKS2

Year 3: In Maths we have been multiplying numbers using the formal written method and we have solved a range of multi-step words problems involving multiplication. In Literacy we have focused on words that are commonly misspelt and we have learned how various nouns are pluralised.

In Science we have learned about 'Sun Safety', discussing the possible dangers from excessive exposure to sunlight and what we can do stay safe. Year 3 have completed their Spring assessments for Reading, Maths, SPaG and Writing to show the fantastic progress we have made since the start of the academic year.

Year 4: In Maths we have learned about angles. We have been identifying acute, obtuse and right angles. We have also been using the protractor to measure specified angles. We have focused on present perfect tense in Literacy and we have learned about using conjunctions for time and cause.

In afternoon lessons we have investigated conductors and insulators in Science and learned about open mindedness and tolerance in our RE session. We have also completed our Spring assessments this week to show how much we have learned so far in our year group.
