What we have been up to in LKS2

Year 3: In Maths we have reinforced our understanding of various topics in preparation of assessment week. We have learned more about adding/subtracting fractions, equivalent fractions and working out fractions of amounts. We have also secured our understanding of time (analogue and digital).
