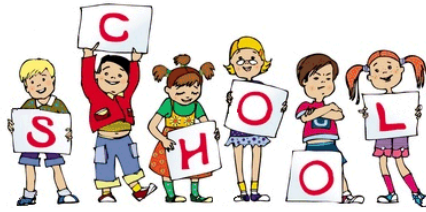




Friday 27th May

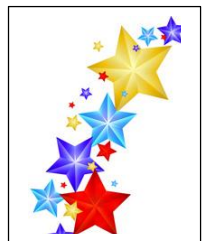
