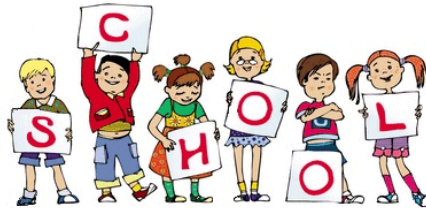




Friday 10th June
