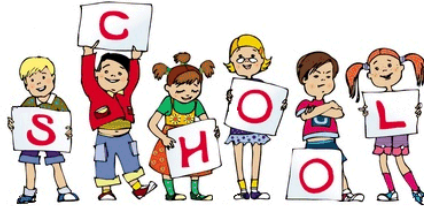




Friday 8th July
