Dear Parent / Carer,

Our Nursery children will be visiting Smithills Farm, to enhance our topic learning.

The trip will take place on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May.

The educational visit will be during the school day, therefore your child will need to be at school at **8:50am** as the coach will depart at **10:00am** prompt (late arrivals may not be able to attend). The coach should return to school by 3:10pm however, we will keep parents informed of any delay via School Spider and Class Dojo.

**If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch from our school kitchen.** Please ensure **1 week before the date of the trip** a meal is booked for this via School Spider. Order **any** meal for them as the children have already chosen in class from ham, tuna or cheese.

If your child is **not** entitled to free school meals you can either:

- Send your child with a packed lunch from home - please ensure any previous order made on School Spider has been cancelled **1 week before the date of the trip**. If, by this deadline, a child still has a hot meal in the system the school will provide them with a packed lunch of their choice and the account will be charged.

Or

- Order a packed lunch for them using School Spider **1 week before the date of the trip**. If, by this deadline, a child still has a hot meal in the system the school will provide them with a packed lunch of their choice and the account will be charged.

**Any packed lunches must come in a labelled plastic disposable bag with packaging that can be thrown away.**

Pupils are required to be in full school uniform for the educational visit. Due to the time of year, please ensure your child has appropriate clothing including waterproof shoes and a waterproof jacket/sun hat and sun cream.
